Libraries Rock!, the Summer Reading Club for children, opens on June 25. Children of all ages can hop on the band wagon as summer is a time for kids to read for FUN! For this reason, we focus on interest level instead of reading level, and all types of books are encouraged, including e-books and audio books. Children will earn a badge for every seven days of being read aloud to or reading on their own. The program runs through August 16.

Once you have completed your first seven days of reading, you may pick up your T-shirt beginning July 2. When the Summer Reading Game ends, you may continue to record the books you have read until you return to school.

Program Registration Information:

- ◆ A sign-up date is listed for each program that requires registration.
- ◆ Online registration is encouraged. Visit www.wtmlib.info. From the drop-down menu under "What's Happening" choose "Calendar". Find the program and click the button to register. *Locked and Rockin' in the Library* and *Nutmeg Book Discussions* do not offer online registration.
- ◆ Glastonbury residents are given priority for all registered programs. Nonresidents may register on the date listed if space is available in the program.

How to Play the Reading Game

1. Choose something fun and begin reading on June 25. Read or have someone read to you for about 20 minutes per day. Color in the music note or piano key that matches the date you read.
2. Once you have colored your first seven days, you are ready to register for the program. Beginning July 2, bring your booklet to the Children's Department to sign up and to receive your t-shirt!
2. Add each book to your reading log when you finish it. A paper log is in your booklet, or you can list your titles online at www.wtmlib.info. Start your online list using the link on the library's home page. *Elementary school students: you must record the titles of the books you've read for the Governor's Summer Reading Challenge.* Younger children may do so if they wish.
3. Continue reading and coloring each date. Children will earn badges for each additional seven days of reading completed through August 16. Bring your booklet to the library to collect badges.
4. Children may collect badges until 5:00pm on August 18. T-shirts will be available through the start of school while supplies last.
