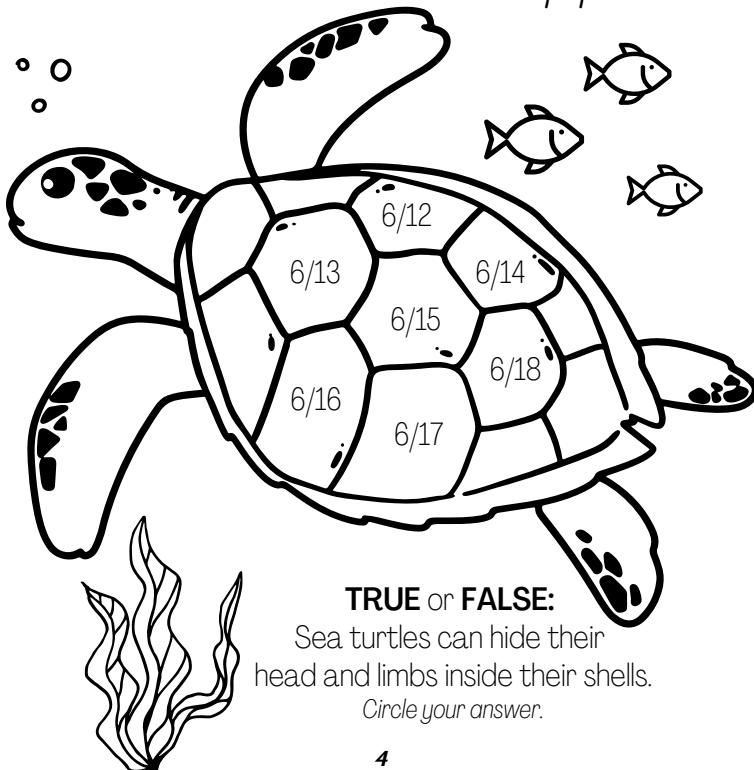

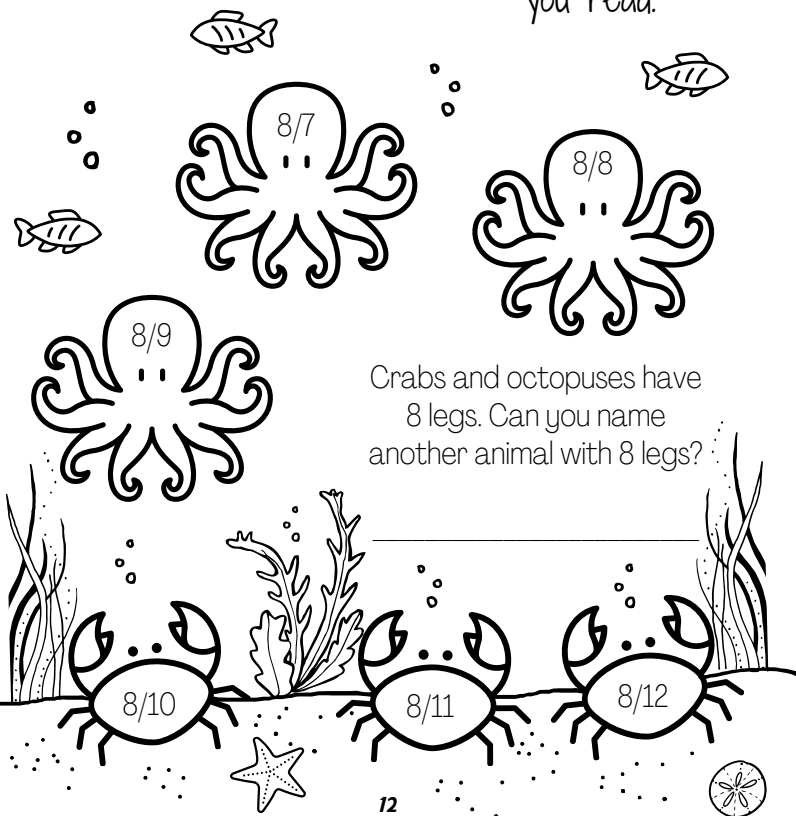

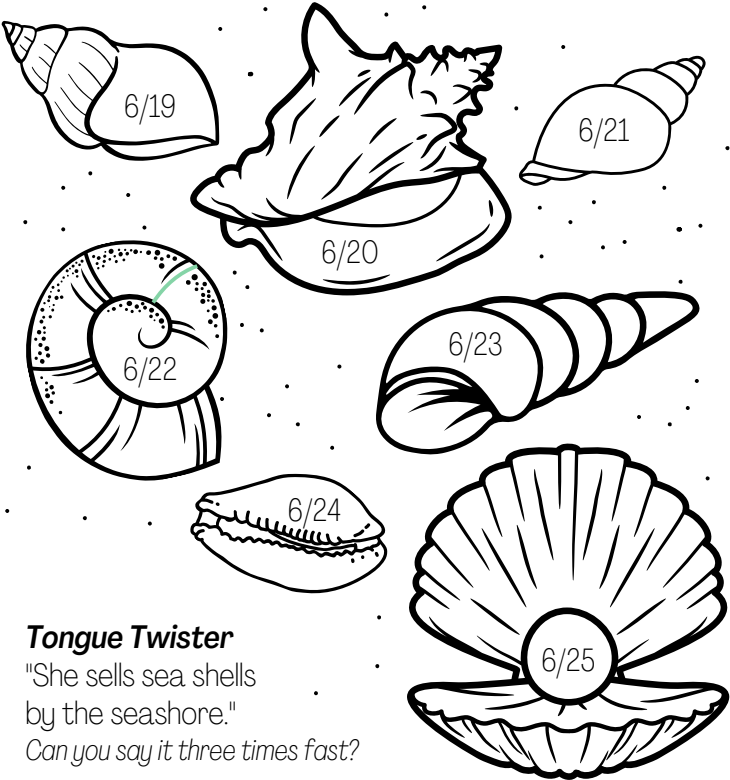

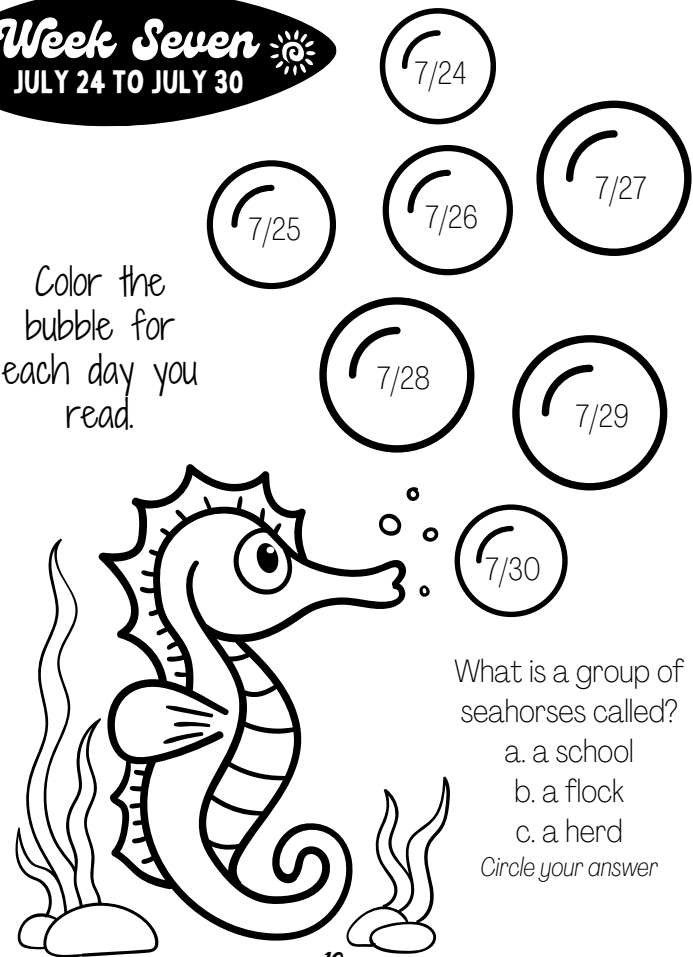

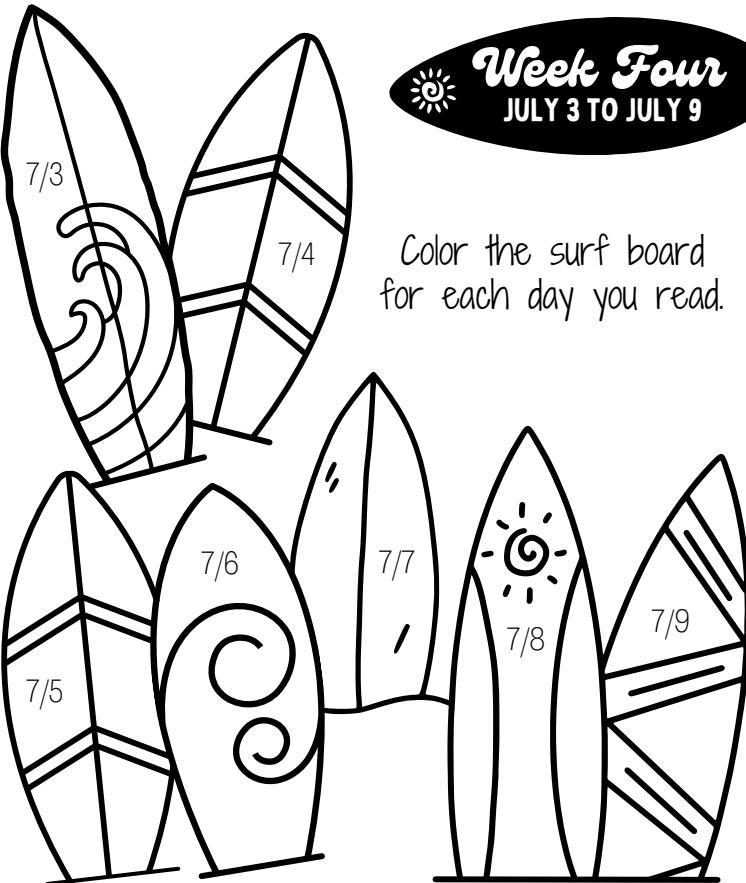

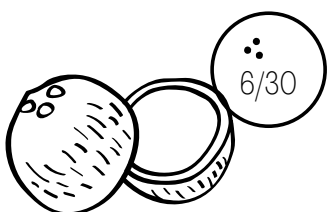

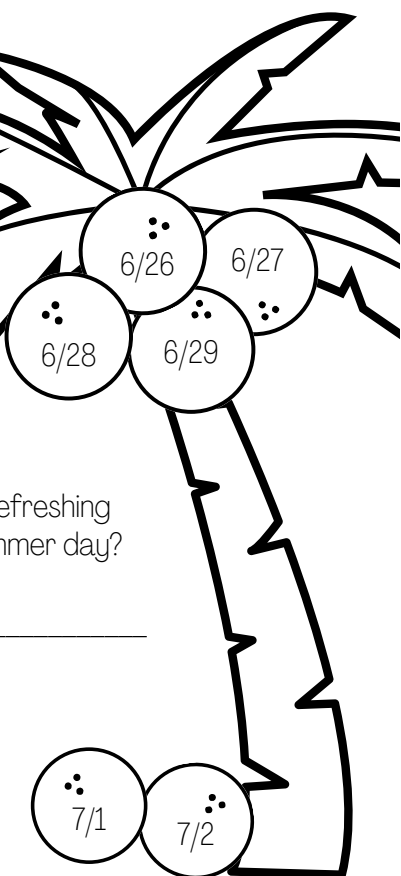

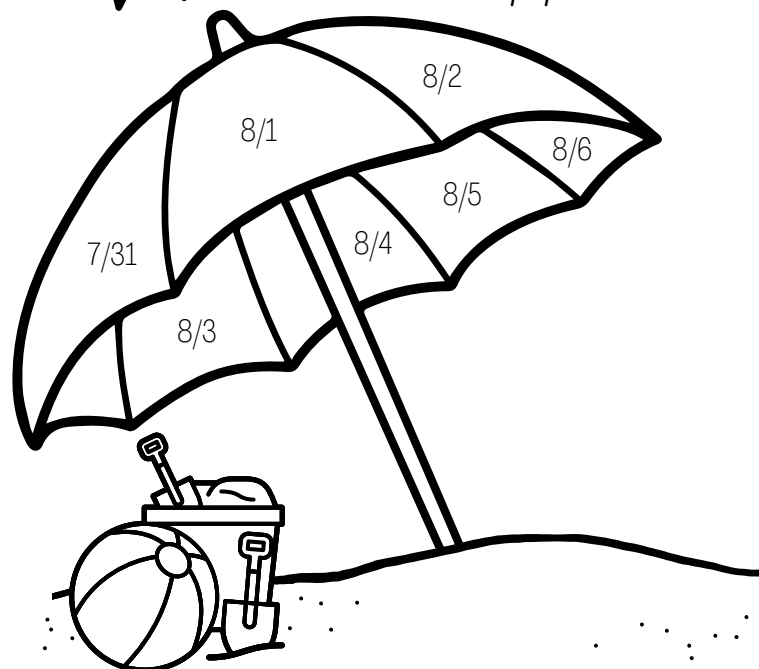

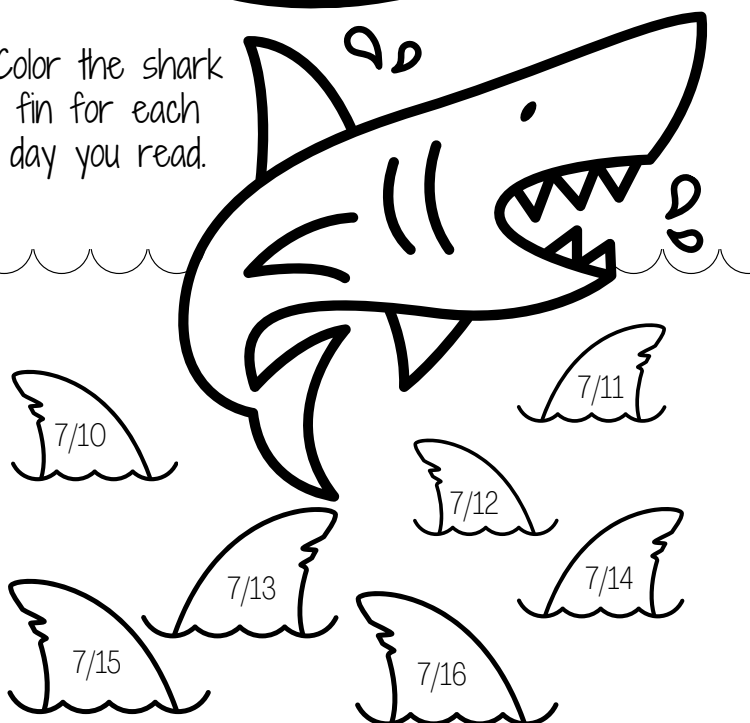


Draw a sandcastle in the sand.

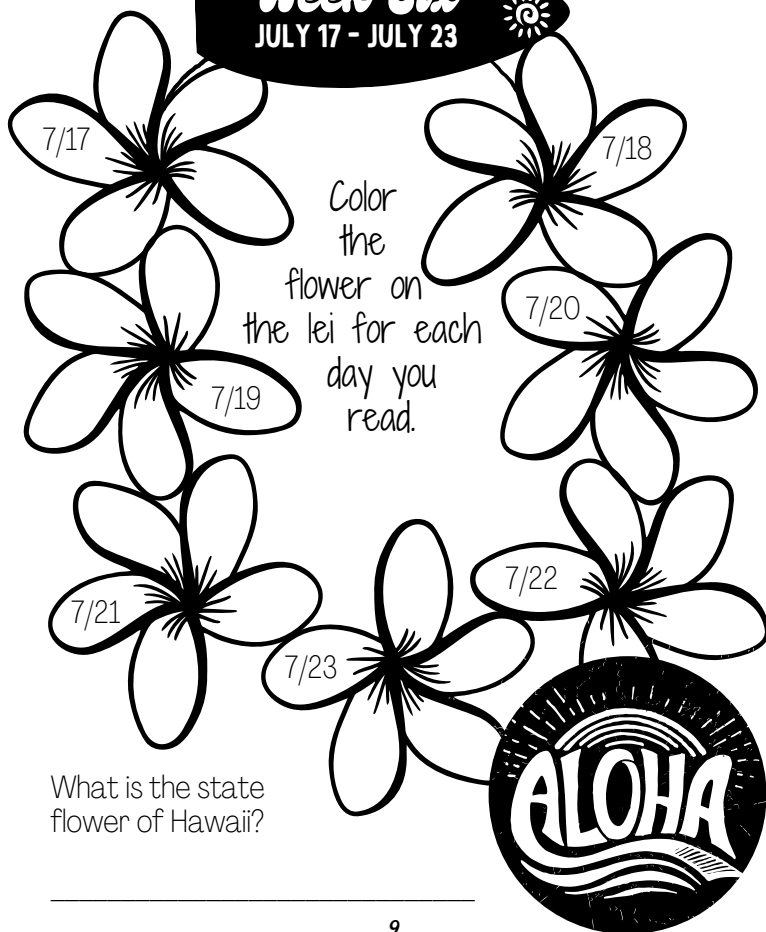
How many sharks are swimming **left**?
